Best Practice Tips:



- Clothing has the resident's name & facility only.
- Do not put room numbers on clothing labels.
- Check clothing labels before dressing resident's to make sure it's their own clothing.
- Bring new clothes & gifts to the desk to be labeled before taking to the residents room.
- Bring unmarked, unlabeled clothes to housekeeping.
- Recommended clothing: durable, blended fabrics, machine washable and colorfast.
- Inventory a resident's clothes every 6 months.



The Net Bags

- Net bags should be clearly labeled with the facility name and room number.
- Net bags belong to the room, not the resident.
- Make sure correct bag is in the correct closet & hamper.
- This is not next day or dry cleaning service. Allow for 2-3 day turnaround time.
- If more net bags are needed please inform housekeeping.
- Don't cross out or re-label bags.
- Clothing and linen are laundered separately. Look for items of clothing that might be stuck in with the sheets and remove them.
