Unitex Makes Generous Donation for Relief in Puerto Rico

October 18, 2017, Perth Amboy, NJ– Mayor Wilda Diaz of Perth Amboy, NJ, held a press conference to honor Unitex and other Perth Amboy based businesses and community partners for their generous efforts in providing assistance to Puerto Rico since Hurricane Maria devastated the island. Over three weeks in October, 400,000 pounds of goods and nearly \$50,000 were collected as part of the city's fundraising effort. Thousands of people, businesses, and nonprofit



organizations responded to Perth Amboy's community-wide call for assistance which included Unitex's Med-Apparel Division in Perth Amboy. According to the Mayor, supplies were loaded on ships sailing to San Juan, Puerto Rico the weekend of October 14th.

"We are inspired by the City of Perth Amboy and everyone who has come together to help the various communities in Puerto Rico," said David Potack, President of Unitex. "The past few months have been challenging for many, so it's important to see business leaders like those in this city lend a helping hand."



Beware of phishing emails, fake 'virus' alerts, phony support calls, and other scams

Recently con artists have been calling or emailing people across the United States and Canada, claiming iCloud, Netflix, and Microsoft accounts have been hacked or need updated billing information, according to a recent Better Business Bureau (BBB) warning. The callers are persistent, with some people receiving 10 or more calls a day. The calls may display "Apple Inc." or the name of your local Apple Store on your caller ID.



The calls that claim to be from Apple Support inform you that your iCloud account was hacked. You're asked to stay on the line and speak to a "technician" who will ask for remote access to your computer to fix your account, which will expose you to identity theft by giving them an opportunity to install malware that records passwords or hunts for information on your computer such as bank account numbers.

Also an email scam targeting Netflix users aims to gather personal information from the streaming service's 110 million subscribers. The suspicious emails tell recipients that their Netflix billing information needs

updating and takes them to a fake Netflix website. There they are asked to log in and enter information including credit card numbers.

Be extra careful with any unsolicited call, text, or email

The scammers are incredibly sophisticated who mimic email and text messages from legitimate companies to trick you into entering personal information and passwords. Never follow links or open attachments in suspicious or unsolicited messages. If you need to change or update personal information, contact the company directly.

These signs can help you identify phishing scams:

- The sender's email address or phone number doesn't match the name of the company that it claims to be from.
- Your email address or phone number is different from the one that you gave that company.
- The message starts with a generic greeting, like "Dear customer." Most legitimate companies will include your name in their messages to you.
- A link appears to be legitimate but takes you to a website whose URL doesn't match the address of the company's website.
- The message looks significantly different from other messages that you've received from the company.
- The message requests personal information, like a credit card number or account password.
- The message is unsolicited and contains an attachment.
